METHODOLOGY

The poll was conducted through face-to-face interviews from April 25-May 12, 2009 with 600 urban Egyptians in the areas of Cairo, Alexandria, Giza, and Subra. These four urbanized areas represent 75 percent of Egypt's urban population, which is 42 percent of the national population. The margin of error is 4.1 percent.
